- COMPLETE A LIABILITY WAIVER and SIGN IN SHEET available at www.acgov.org/wellness
- COMPLY with the Mandatory "BUDDY POLICY" Two or more employees must be present at all times during physical activity.
- 3. Employees' participation in these activities is on a voluntary basis and is undertaken on their own time. These activities are not part of the employee's work-related duties.
