What is AiMUP?

AiMUP stands for Administrative Minor Use Permit, designed to streamline certain uses that will facilitate business recovery and improve the permitting process for applicants.

Who can apply?

- 1. Outdoor Commercial Use
 - a. Outdoor seating for dining purposes
 - b. Outdoor seating/meal service for on-site alcohol service with on-site meal service.
 - c. Outdoor personal services (cosmetologists, barber shops, beauty salons, and other similar personal grooming services)
 - d. Outdoor retail including merchandise display areas
 - e. Outdoor fitness classes or training
- 2. Outdoor community facilities
- 3. Pop-up spaces and uses for food preparation and service or for retail
- 4. Mobile food, beverage or retail uses (e.g. food trucks) located at specified private property locations (applicant is a property owner rather than a roving food truck)
- 5. Musical performances (including amplified music) accessory to existing use
- 6. Minor façade changes including signage

Are there any time restrictions for this permit?

- 1. Outdoor commercial 5 years
- 2. Outdoor community facilities 5 years
- 3. Pop-up spaces and uses 1 year
- 4. Mobile food, beverage, or retail uses (such as but not limited to food trucks) 1 year
- 5. Musical performances 1 year
- f6. Minor façade changes including signage no time limit

Why was this permit created?

AiMUP streamlines the approval process for minor projects that meet the applicable zoning
